Responsibilities:

- Provide remote counseling services to clients of R.E.G.A.L. Counseling Services are designed to support helping individuals, mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being of individuals, couples, and families by integrating faith-based principles with professional therapeutic practices.
- Apply evidence-based therapeutic techniques and faith integrated approaches where appropriate.
- Counsel clients on a range of issues, including anxiety, depression, trauma, grief, relationship struggles, addiction, spiritual struggles, and other mental health concerns.
- Develop individualized treatment plans by utilizing evidence based therapeutic techniques.
- Assess clients' mental health needs and create appropriate intervention strategies.
- Ensure all client information and communications are kept confidential in compliance with HIPAA and other ethical guidelines.
- Prepare treatment summaries and provide referrals when necessary.
- Document treatment plans, progress notes, and other required paperwork in a timely and organized manner.

Qualifications

- Master's degree or higher in Counseling, Psychology, Social Work, or a related field.
- Minimum of 1 year of counseling experience.
- Strong communication, ethical, and organizational skills.
